There's more. Enjoy full-service RV camping. Nightly fees are \$25.00 for non-serviced sites and \$35.00 for serviced sites (plus HST). Serviced campsites include 20/30 amp and 50-amp capability with direct water hook-up. Amenities include fresh water access, toilets and showers, and refuse.

Other complimentary components include shaded picnic areas with tables, and paved wheelchair-accessible paths. The Fort William Trading Post in the Visitor Centre provides goods and services, featuring souvenirs, gifts, pop, water, and ice sales.

Admission to historic Fort William or to special events is separate from camp site fees.
